Brewing

Brewed in Bannockburn on the banks of the Kowarau River. Each small batch is fermented and aged in Pinot Noir barrels. Once barrel aging is complete Killarabbit is bottled and undergoes a secondary bottle fermentation, this process is known as bottle conditioning. Killarabbit is not filtered or fined and therefore will have a small deposit at the bottom of the bottle.

Tasting Note

Pacific Gem and Nelson Sauvín hops combined to produce a unique mix of tropical fruits and piney bitterness. Massive mouthfeel is delivered from the ale and crystal malts, providing perfect balance to the citrus and floral notes. NZ Cascade hops provide a clean finish with strong and smooth bitterness.
